Rewarding teens for choosing to remain substance free!

Students who apply for membership complete an application and take a simple drug test (with a parent's consent). When the test shows Belmont County Schools Staying Clean that the teen is substance free, they're in the Club!

Members receive a full-color photo ID card proving that they are participating. The card can be shown at school and local businesses for special rewards specifically designed to recognize substance free teens. Rewards vary from school to school, but can be anything from free desserts to discounted tickets or special perks unavailable to others. As an extra perk, membership looks great on applications, especially for those in the Club all through school.

Retesting of random members continues throughout the school year. As long as test come back substance free, the rewards continue!

Why retest? The possibility of a test gives members an EASY escape if they find themselves in a situation where they are pressured to experiment with drugs...

Since members are seen getting rewards, peers know it's true that they could be tested anytime.

Parental consent and a valid email address are required for all applications regardless if they are on paper or online.

Turn in your form

Test substance free!

Applicants will be tested when we come to get this year's Club started.

Get the ID card

Depending on the lab and photo schedule, cards may be sent up to a few weeks after test day.

Stay Substance free!
